The Gloria, a prayer of rejoicing, is omitted from the liturgy throughout Lent, in line with this spirit of reflection. On Holy Thursday, the Gloria returns to our liturgy marking the end of our lenten observances as we rejoice at the beginning of the Easter season and the resurrection of our Lord.
