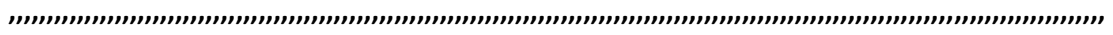

The course is suitable for all ages and covers a range of Emergency Life Support Skills (ELS) including

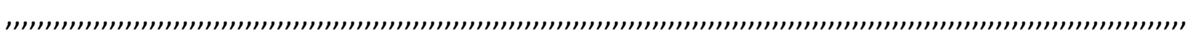
- . Dealing with an unconscious casualty
