On October 4th, Pope Leo signed <u>Dilexi Te</u>, his first Apostolic Exhortation. A short extract

"This "preference" (for the poor) never indicates exclusivity or discrimination towards other groups which would be impossible for God. It is meant to emphasize God's actions, which are moved by compassion toward the poverty and weakness of all humanity. Wanting to inaugurate a kingdom of justice, fraternity and solidarity, God has a special place in his heart for those who are discriminated against and, and he asks us, his Church, to make a decisive and radical choice in favour or the weakest."

(Paragraph 16)

Here, Pope Leo addresses an understandable emotional response to the idea of a preferential option for the poor. He explains that this preference does not diminish God's love for those who have plenty. Instead, His heart for the poor is intricately tied to His justice and love. God is like a parent whose love and care for the needs of one child does not diminish love for another.
