<u>Liturgical Word of the Week</u> Holy Mass

Holy Mass is made up of two principal parts: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In this week's Gospel, we see a blueprint of Holy Mass as the disciples encounter Jesus on the road to Emmaus. Through the explanation of Scriptures and then the revelation of the True Presence in the Eucharist, through the gift of grace, the eyes of the disciples are opened as Jesus is revealed to them. We have this same encounter every time we attend Holy Mass through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist.
