Each book tells us about the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Gospel reading is the high point of the Liturgy of the Word during Mass. The gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke are known as the Synoptic Gospels, because they include many of the same stories, often in the same sequence. The Gospel of John – is written to show the miracles of Jesus, so that those who read his story will believe in him and have everlasting life.
