Liturgical word of the Week

Creed - The word Creed comes from the Latin Credo meaning "believe". At Mass every Sunday, and on Solemnities, we profess our Faith which generally take the form of either the Apostles Creed or the Nicene Creed. The Apostles Creed is one of the earliest professions of Faith which identifies and reiterates some of the most fundamental aspects of Christian doctrine. While the Nicene Creed is the result of two ecumenical councils - Nicea in 325 and Constantinople 381 - and was a response to heresies.
