Our Lady of the Isles is a sculpture of the Madonna and Child, on South Uist in the Outer Hebrides.

It was commissioned shortly after the Ministry of Defence proposed a missile testing range be constructed. This caused concern it would destroy much of the island's way of life, culture and language. Resistance to the proposals was led by Canon John Morrison, the local parish priest.

Liturgical Word of the Week

Liturgy of the Eucharist - The Eucharistic Prayer is the heart of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Eucharistic Prayers make clear that these prayers are offered, not to Christ, but to the Father. It is worship offered to the Father by Christ as it was at the moment of his passion, death and resurrection, but now it is offered through the priest acting in the person of Christ.

Foodbank

You may have seen the article in the Greenock Telegraph about the foodbank where we send all our donations.

In the last six months donations are down by 42% and demand has risen by over a third.

The donations from the parish have been very steady and have probably increased slightly over that time and thank you for that. Since January the parish has donated 429 Kgs, heading for half a ton.

There is a new site **Donation Genie** which when you put in the postcode shows what the local foodbank requires and doesn't really require.

Just now they have plenty, pasta, beans and cereals but need tinned foods, UHT milk and shampoo.
