The Ciborium. This is a chalice-like vessel used to contain the Blessed Sacrament. It is used for distributing Holy Communion in churches and for reserving the consecrated hosts in the tabernacle. The vessel can be made of either silver or gold, but the interior of the cup must be lined with gold
